# **DHS Letter on PLAs**

On September 20, 2010, BCANJ sent a sample letter to contractor members urging them to personalize and forward it via e-mail to the Department of Homeland Security. DHS had issued a request for comments regarding the implementation of PLAs on the construction and renovation of the William J. Hughes Technical Center, also called the Transportation Security Laboratory, at the Atlantic City airport. The sample letter addressed the benefits of a PLA, including cost-savings, labor stabilization, access to a skilled labor pool and leveling the playing field for union and non-union contractors through a PLA.

## Legislative Gaming Summits Conclude

The last in a series of legislative gaming summits took place in late September at Monmouth Racetrack. The focus of the hearings has been the future of the gambling, horse racing and sports industries in our state. The summits have come in response to Governor Christie's Gaming Task Force's findings. BCANJ testified at past hearings and strongly advocated for future building projects to revitalize various gaming regions in the state, which could create opportunities for New Jersey contractors and the union workforce they employ. The Legislature will now have the task of implementing findings from the hearings into legislative action. BCANJ will maintain an active role in the development of these future legislative proposals.

# President Signs Small-Business Legislation

In late September, President Obama signed legislation that will provide credit assistance and tax cuts for small businesses. The Small Business Jobs Act makes possible billions of dollars worth of tax cuts over the next 12 months by allowing companies to more quickly write off the cost of purchases. In addition, the newly signed legislation cuts fees and increases limits on loan guarantees offered by the US Small Business Administration.

### **EPA** Construction Stormwater Survey

In Bulletin #80-10, BCANJ informed members that US EPA is currently collecting information from owners/developers of residential, non-residential, industrial and commercial sites via a survey. The survey was mailed in mid-September directing those in receipt of the questionnaire to complete it within 60 days. According to EPA, the Agency did not direct the survey to general contractors. However, if any member received the survey, it is

important to complete and submit it in advance of the 60-day deadline. Members can access the bulletin on the "Members Only" section of the BCANJ website.

#### Work Halted on ARC Tunnel

As we alerted members in Hot Topics on our website, in mid-September the Federal Transit Administration halted any new work on the trans-Hudson tunnel for 30 days pending a review of project costs. NJ Transit is conducting the review.

#### **OSHA 30-Hour Course**

As we told you in Bulletin #79-10, BCANJ will host an OSHA 30-Hour Construction Health & Safety Course December 7, 14 & 21, 2010 (Tuesdays), at the Association Office in Edison. The course will cover OSHA policies, procedures and standards as well as construction safety and health principles. The cost is \$329 per person for BCANJ and affiliated association members, and includes a continental breakfast, lunch and course materials. ## OSHA 502 Trainer Refresher Course

Per Bulletin #71-10, BCANJ will host the OSHA 502 "Trainer Refresher" Course on October 26 & 27, 2010, from 8 am to 5 pm at the Association Office, Edison. The OSHA 502 is for individuals who have taken the OSHA 500 and need to renew their certification. Cost is \$529 per person for BCANJ and affiliated association members. # Multi-Employer Citation Policy Upheld

In a reversal of a previous decision, on August 19, 2010, the Occupational Safety and Health Review Commission upheld OSHA's multi-employer citation policy. The policy allows OSHA inspectors to cite employers on multi-employer jobsites for violations even if those violations don't expose their own workers to occupational hazards. This latest decision was made in the well-known Summit Contractors case, which has seen decisions go to opposite extremes several times since OSHA issued the citation in 2005.
